TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND CONGRESSMAN JOE KILGORE (to Congressman Kilgore)

LBJ: Heilo Joe...I wanted to drop you a little note but I haven't had time...

I'm been on this telephone all day and I've had folks coming in...had
the Prime Minister of Denmark...had the Prince of Cambodia...gave
him hell..he told us he didn't want us ever and I said..we don't want
any friends that don't want us...laughter..it just means less foreign
aid funds ... with that attitude...

JK He understands that, doesn't he?

LBJ Yes, he did. He said he didn't know much about this. I said I'd have to talk to him about it later...laugher. O.K. pardner, you check with James if you can and come ever..there's not going to be anybody there but Homer.

JK 7:30? Allright..come..just come ever to your house.

LBJ And you'd better ask somebody at the White House to call..tell them that you're coming. Call Waiter's office...Juanita Roberts...one or the other. Tell them to tell Secret Service and that you're coming to dinner..what kind of car you've get so they'll let you in.

JK All right. We'lll do that. Thank you.

LBJ OK
