

Re: Telephone Conversation between the President and [Governor Frank Clement], 11/28/63, 6:30 p.m.

While working on preservation of the dictabelts, the archives staff observed that the transcript incorrectly identifies the conversation as a conversation with "Earle Clement." The President's Daily Diary indicates that the conversation was with "Gov. Clement," and the White House Telephone Operators' Logs indicate the conversation was with "Governor Frank Clement." During the conversation the President addresses the other party as "Frank."
