TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND SEN. COOPER (t)

LBJ

.....

.....today establishing a Presidential Commission composed of 7 distinguished Americans headed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the U.S. I've ~~announced~~ after full consultation with the leaders of the Congress and with members of my own Cabinet. This Commission will be establish<sup>ed</sup>/before the end of the day by Executive Order. Its functions will be to receive and to evaluate information by all sources of the Executive Branch to satisfy itself the truth is known as far as we can know it and report its findings and conclusions to me to the American people and to the world.
