

IN MINSK THERE WAS A 25 FT. STONE MONUMENT TO STALIN WHICH STOOD EVEN AFTER THE RUEFUL DENUNCIATION OF STALIN BY KHRUSHCHEV, until THE MONUMENT OF STALIN IN LEVINGRAD WHICH WAS TORN DOWN IMMEDIATELY. THIS IMMENSE BRONZE AND MARBLE STRUCTURE WAS STANDING FOR AS LONG AS IT WAS DUE TO THE EFFORTS OF RICHARD STALINIST SUCH AS COVN. RETM. ROFEE AND OVR. OFFICE IN MINSK AND OTHERS. HOWEVER, AFTER THE 22nd CONVENTION OF STALIN, ON NOV. 5 TWO DAYS BEFORE THE NOV. 7 REVOLUTIONARY CELEBRATIONS, A FORCE OF 100 MEN DESCENDED UPON THE STALIN SQUARE FIR (NOW LENIN SQUARE) AND WITH BULLDOZERS AND PILEDRIVER IMMEDIATELY TO TERRIFY (NOT SALVAGE) THE STRUCTURE. THEY MUST HAVE BEEN VERY ENTHUSIASTIC BECAUSE NEXT DAY THEY HAD REMOVED THE 10 TON BRONZE STATUE OF A MAN KNOWN BY THE OLDER GENERATION AND LAUGHED AT BY THE SARCASTIC YOUNGER GENERATION.

THE MOST REMARKABLE THING ABOUT THE DESTRUCTION OF THIS GIANT MONUMENT WAS THAT WORK WAS CEASED ON THE 6th OF NOVEMBER. BUT STARTED AGAIN ON THE 7th THE VERY DAY A BIG PARADE OF BORDELLERS CAME BY. THE MONUMENT WAS RIGIDLY PROTECTED FROM ITS REVIEWING STAND AS IF IT WERE

IN FULL VIEW OF ALL WORKERS

AND WORKERS GOING BY THE DESTRUCTION OF STALIN AND THE SYMBOLIC ENDING OF STALINISM — (UPROACHED HOPE) WAS CONCLUDED.

BUT GEORGIA AS IN STALIN'S NATIVE GEORGIA IS STILL A STRONGHOLD OF STALINISM.

AND A REVIVAL OF STALINISM IS A VERY REAL POSSIBLE THING IN THOSE TWO REPUBLICS.
