The Embassy has had no contact with Oswald since his departure from the Matropole Hotel in Moscow in November, 1959, and has no clew as to his present whereabouts.

The Embassy has no evidence that Oswald has expatriated himself other than his amounced intention to do so, and the Embassy is, therefore, technically in a position to institute an inquiry concern-ing his whereabouts through a note to the Foreign Office. We believe, ing his knowed through a note that the supplication in the Embassy were to trensmit to the Foreign Ministry, in connection with a formal inquiry or simply alone, a personal letter to Oswald from his mother with the request that it be forwarded to Oswald. This technique appears to have been effective in the case 20
