On November 22, 1963, at approximately 2:50PM, the undersigned officer met Special Agent James Hooty of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the basement of the City Hall.

At that time Special Agent Hooty related to this officer that the Subject was a member of the Communist Party, and that he was residing in Dallas.


The Subject was arrested for the murder of Officer J.D. Tippit and is a prime suspect in the assassination of President Kennedy.

The information regarding the Subject's affiliation with the Communist Party is the first information this officer has received from the Federal Bureau of Investigation regarding same.

Agent Hooty further stated that the Federal Bureau of Investigation was aware of the Subject and that they had information that this Subject was capable of committing the assassination of President Kennedy.
