Hrs. Canald, neo Karian Micholsovan Prusakova, born July 17, 1981 at Holstowak, Union of Scridt Souldiet Republice, in the wife of Lee Marvey Canald. Mr. Canald, who was born Ceteber 18, 1939 at Mew Chlenne, defected to the Seriet Union in Subber 1939, shortly after complating a three-year emilatment in the United States Marine Corpa. Although a report from the Federal Burean of Investigation (contained in the ITIC) stated he had had no known contant with the Communist Party of America and had shown no preclivities for communication to the Unbourge at Moreau that he intended to become a Coviet national and to reveal to the Soviet authorities all the information he could show that training in the Marine Canald ware married April 29, 1981 and precently reside at Himsk, where a child was recently born to them. We Canald has now become dictillusioned with life in the Union of Soviet Scalalist Republica and wichout for roturn to this country with his faulty.
