EMMRY SECTL, 2738 Pine Grove Avenue, Apartment 201, Chicago, Illinois, was contacted at his employment in the United States Postal Cullatation at 227 West Ontario, where SDETL is employed as a Postal Carrier.

SEGEL advised that he is well acquainted with JACH RUBY due to the fact that years ago, he, SECL was a close friend of HARTIN GHIPFL, who was a close friend of RUBY. He recalls that RUBY grew up in the neighborhood of the west side of Chicago and was well known to ELMM people there by the nicknams of "SPARTY".

SCEL advised that in 1949 and again in 1950, to and GILPEL visited RUBY in Dallas, Toras, where RUBY at that time was operating the Silver Sper. GILPEL died in September of 1962 and following that SECEL went to Dallas to tell RUBY about GILPEL's death. Ee lived with RUBY for approximately a wook to ten days but spent part of this time.

SECIL advised that due to the fact that REBY grow up under hard financial circumstances during the Leprension days, he was always hard up for money and as a result "scratched for money all his life." To the knowledge of SECEL, BEBY nover had any kind of a salaried job in his life. He purchased football tickets and scalped them and SECEL also recalls that EWBY sold little pleater busts of President FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVALT. SECEL recalls RUBY as being a very good street fighter and a man who was very successful with worma.

SECIL also know REBY as being a "vory, very contional man and then was very moody and sentimental". SHELL stated that RUBY could go vory quickly from depression to happiness and vice versa. He was a deg lover and very loyal to his friends. SECIL feels that RUBY's act in killing OSWALD was "his way of empressing a promitte gesture" and that RUBY "went crazy" about what he felt was a terrible thing and did this on the

SEGEL described RUBY as "100% American". He recalls that RUBY even disliked consdran VAUCHN MEADOR because MEADOR specialized in initation specifing President KENNEDY. SEGEL advised that he cannot believe that RUBY acted as a part of a bonspiracy or that he was involved with anyone in this act.

SEGEL advised that he wrote a letter dated November 30, to RUBY at the County Jail in Dallas, in which he expressed his continued friendship for RUBY and wished him luck.

SEGEL could think of no nutual friends who night also know RUBY.

SEGEL advised that to his knowledge RUBY never gambled.
