LEON H. WORTH, 2018 South Tyler Street, was interviewed concerning his knowledge and or association with JACK RUFY.

Mr. WORTH stated he presently operates a private club stated this 707 McKinney Avenue in Delles known as the Geloxy Club. We stated this is a private club, and he formerly operated the Top Hat Lounge located in Delles. He stated he operated the Top Hat Lounge about ten years ago at which time JACK RUBY was operating a lounce known as the Silver Sour.

He stated he has known RUEY for emproximately ten yea... and become acquainted with him insemuch as he was operating the Top Hat Lounge at the same time RUEY was running the Silver Spur.

He stated at no time has he ever considered himself a personal friend of RUBY's and had never to his recollection gone to dinner with him or had drinks with him either in a coffee shop or a lounge.

Mr. WORTH stated about 1954 he divested himself of the ounge business and went in the pharmaceutical business as him or pharmacist.

He stated FUBY came to him at the time he was in the pharmaceutical business with a recedy for treating arthritisted FUBY wanted him to sell this arthritis remedy and would receive \$100.00 a week and commissions for selling this remedy.

WORTH stated he sold this arthritis remedy for RUBY for about three months but after that time several of the checks which RUBY gave him for commission were no account checks, and so he quit doing business with RUBY and quit solling his arthritis remedy.

Mr. WORTH stated after he quit solling the arthrit's remedy he had no further contact with XUBY, and up until approximately two nths ago had not seen him although he had known he was in the Dalles arec. He stated he awn RUBY in Phil's Delicatessen with a bunch of show people whom he believed were enterteiners at the club operated by RUBY. Mr. WORTH stated he did not know any of these people and did not know of a close friends of RUBY.

He stated he never considered himself a personal friend

of RUEY and had never arranged for any losss nor had he lorsed him any money for the purpose of operating a lounge or other business. He stated RUBY is the kind of person who is elveys trying to force his friendship on you, and he did not consider RUEY trustworthy or reliable and believed that RUEY would do snything for a "buck".

Mr. WRZH stated he was class of the opinion RUEN pressure! "Gry on, any" and further explained bits by saying he believed RUEN preferred the company of mon rather than of when. "He stated he has no personal knowledge of homosexual tendencies in RUEN and ther RUEN est bited Cemining tendencies in his actions and talk. He stated he will not believe that RUEN was a fighter or brewler as he had been characterized recently in measureper clippings. He stated RUEN was a backslapper and he believed RUEN would do anything for publicity or money.

He stated he does not know of his own knowledge that RUBY is a narcotics user or that he drinks to excess.

WORTH stated that "JACK is not for snybody else but JACK RUBY". He stated he does not know enything about RUBY's politics and does not believe that RUBY is particularly particular interested in politics other than in politics to promote himself.

Mr. WORTH stated that his wife and PUBY did not get wlong at all, and he believed that RUEY was jealous of his wife because of the husband and wife relationship.

Mr. WORTH stated he did not ever kno. RUBY to carry a gun and did not believe RUBY was an aggressive person.

WORTH stated he did not know any close friends that RUBY might have, and he personally did not core for RUBY in any form.
