DETAILS

SYNOPSIS

New York office requested to make inquiry at the schools which Leo Harvey Oswald attended while residing in New York City.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to previous reports in this case, particularly the M/R of Special Agent George J. Serben, New York, dated 12-5-63.

The purpose of this phase of the investigation is to develop all possible background information on Leo Harvey Oswald up until the time of his return from Russia.

Other Investigations

On December 10, 1963, Marguerite Oswald was interviewed at her home, 2200 Thomas Place, Fort Worth, Texas. She stated that she and Leo Harvey Oswald moved to New York City in September 1952, and that, for a short while, they resided with her oldest son, John E. Pic. She is unable to remember Pic's address. She stated they left New York in January 1954.

Mrs. Oswald stated that, while she and Leo Oswald were living in Manhattan, he attended a Lutheran school. She stated that he attended a public school located off the concourse in the Bronx; that this school is the one from which he became truant. Mrs. Oswald stated that they then moved to E. 170th Street near the Bronx Zoo, and that Leo Oswald attended a public school near there.
