He stated that he recalled LEE FARVET Of wild applying for amployment with Katz-Besthoff and as best he can recall, this was in the latter part of July or early part of August, 1963. He stated that he could not locate the application arcounted by OSWAID and instanch as it is company policy to destripy applications after two months, it was quite possible that OSWALD's application was destroyed.
