

I was working in that capacity November 23, 1963. I was assigned in front of the cell occupied by Lee Harvey Oswald to keep a close watch on him. At approximately 1:30 p.m., I was advised by Officer Eaves that Oswald wished to use the telephone to make a long distance call. Officer Eaves and I removed Oswald from his cell and placed him in the telephone booth. Officer Eaves advised the City Hall Operator that a prisoner wished to make a long distance call collect. While he was notifying the operator, I wrote Lee Harvey Cowald's name on the telephone log sheet where all prisoners' names are kept when they are permitted to use the telephone. I heard Oswald place a call to New York. After this call, he made a local call. Upon taking Oswald out of the telephone booth, I signed my last name on the telephone log sheet as to removing the prisoner from the booth, and Officer Eaves and I placed him back in his cell. The telephone log sheet on which I entered Oswald's name and which I signed myself has been turned over to Assistant Chief Batchelor.
