Investigation has further determined that only three busses departed from Now Orleans after 8:00 £M on September 25, 1963, and arrived at Houston, Texas prior to 2:00 £M on September 26, 1963. The drivers of these busses have failed to identify a photograph of Cswald as a passenger on these busses. There is no record of Oswald as a passenger on any air flight from New Orleans, Louisiana to Houston, Texas on September 25. 1963.

The only conductor, flagman, and porter assigned to the one train departing New Orleans after 8:00 AM on September 25, 1933 and arriving at Houston, Texas prior to 2:00 AM, September 26, 1833, do not recall Oswald as a passenger.
