ASSOCIATES OF RUBY

EDMARD MEYERS who resides at 1/79 Last 34th Street, Brooklyn, New York, telephone E5 5-2736, and who is the owner and operator of the Queens Beverage Company, a distributor for Pepsi Cola Company, was interviewed at his office, 9/01 Avenue D. Brooklyn, New York, on December 5, 1963. We furnished the following information:

He and his wife had plunned to attend the convention of the American Bottlers of Carbonated Deverages, Dallas, Temas, the week of November 18, 1963.

He had decided to combine this with a vacation trup to Mexico City and visit his wife's sister.

Trior to leaving on this trip, his brother, LAURENCH HAVERS, had visited him in New York and said that he would be in Dallas, Texas, during the same week. They made arrangements to contact one another while in Dallas.

EDUARD MEYERS left with his wife on November 8, 1963, and went to Mexico City. He returned from Mexico City to Dallas, Texas, on the 18th of November via San Antonio, Texas, on American Airlines.

LAMENICE INVERS called EDMARD MEYERS at the Adolphus Notel an Dallas, Texas, on the evening of November 21, 1933, to make arrangements to have dinner together. EDMARD MEYERS was unable to have dinner with his brother, but after subsequent telephone contact, he did meet his brother at the Bon Vivant Room of the Cabina Motel about midnight, November 21. EDMARD MEYERS pointed out that his reservation at the Adolphus Hotel had previously been made for him by the Pepai Cola Company.

At the Bon Vivant Room of the Cabana Motel, LAURENCE MEYERS introduced EDMARD TEYERS to JACK RUBY, He lenew it was just about mighlight because it was too late for them to order any drinks due to a local order.name.

EDNARD MEMERS chatted with RUBY about five minutes. He recalled that RUBY was very talketive and tried to get him interested in a "twist board" which MEMERS said Was some type of promotional glanded. MEMMERS told RUBY he was not interested. Then RUPY had to leave to go back to his club. Present at the time were EDMARD MEMERS, his wife, his brother, LAURENCE MEMERS, and a Tenale companion of his brother, name unknown to EDMARD MEMERS.

EDMARD MEYERS returned to New York, New York via air November 22, 1963, leaving Dallas Airport early in the afternoon. He did observe President Joist F. KENNEDY's arrival at Dallas at the Dallas Airport.

The above was the only contact he had ever had with RUBY. He knows of no connection between RUBY and OSUALD. He had never seen OSUALD at any time. He has never been in the Carousel Club.
