

BJECT: VISAS: OPERATIONS: Third Country Shelter Arrangement

REF: Enhancy's telegram 1558 of November 17, 1961; Enbancy's airgram A-360 of November 17, 1961; Department's telegram 1368 of November 28, 1961.

From the Enhancy's communications referenced above, it is felt there exists some minumerstanding regarding the third country shelter arrangement and its use in cases in which a waiver of the sanctions imposed by Section 233(g) of the ineignation and Nationality Act has not been granted. While that arrangement was originally dowised in order that aliens could title advantage of Soviet exit permits even though quota nuthers had not been received for the issuance of viacs, it may also be used when visus may not be issued in the Soviet Union because of the sanction against such issuance found in Section 23(g). In that connection, attention is called to the working of that section: "*... consular officers performing their duties in the territory of such country to discontinue the issuance of immigrant visas..." (uncorrowing supplied).
