LDE MARVEY COUNTY currently resides at 7018 Devenport, Fort Worth, Texas, with his wife, MARMMA and deeplor JULE LDE ORFALD, COMPALD is uncomployed but is sooking work at Fort Worth.

COUNTED and his family arrived in Fort Worth on Juno 14, 1932. He stheed they left Holland June 4, 1939, by the SS Manadam, and arrived in New York City June 13, 1932, and flew to Love Field, Dallas, Temas, where they arrived on June 14, 1962.

CSUALD stated that he borrowed approximately \$435.00 from the American Embascy with which to make the trip to the United States. CSUALD decided to unswer the question as to why he made the trip to Eussia in the first place. In a show of temper he stated he did not came to "relive the past."

During most of the interview, OSVALD exhibited an impatient and arrogant attitude. OSVALD finally stated that Coviet officials had saised him upon his arrival why he had come to Eussia. OSVALD stated that he told them, "I came because I wanted to." OSVALD added that he went to Eussia to "see the country."

OSUMID actions that newspaper reports which have appeared in the public press from time to time are highly emappeared and untrue. Be stated that the newspaper reports had pictured him as out of sympathy with the United States and had made him look attractive to the Russians, OSUMID stated that by reason of such newspaper reports he had received better treatment by the Soviets than he otherwise would have received.

OSUALD stated that upon his arrival in Russia in Cotober, 1959, he was sont inmediately to Minsk, Bussia, where he was given a job as a netal verker in a television factory. He stated that he spent his time reading blueprints and translating blueprint instructions into the finished product. He advised that he earned eighty rubles per month which was the equivalent of about \$72.00 per month in American money. He advised that he was pormitted to reside at Minsk as a "resident alien."

OSWALD stated that he was able to speak the Russian language upon his arrival. He explained that while he was in
