I have been informed that the Warren Commission is smitcipating the giving of a polygraph test to Jack Ruby in the near future and we have no objection to such test if the questions cover his activities from the time of the assassination of President Kennedy up to the killing of Loe Harvey Oxwald.

In other words, I do not feel that the test should be limited to whether or not he knew Oswald and whether or not he had any assistance in committing the crime. I am most interested in him being questioned concerning when he first thought of killing Oswald and what was his motive in the shooting. In other words, I think the test should cover our evidence of premeditation as well as tha defensive theories in the case.
