ROY LCWHORTER advised he is the City Servant for the Jchovah Vitnesses in the Dallas area. He also advised he resides at 2943 Valley View, Dallas, and there are approximately 15 Jehovah Vitnesses congregations in the Dallas area. Each one of these congrotations maintains its own records regarding mombers and there are no central records for the Dallas area or for the United States.

According to EcVHORTER, a 5 x 7 membership card is initiated and maintained on each member after the member has stayed a sufficient length of time to be baptinged into the Jehovah Witnesses religion. This card is maintained in the files of the organization to which the member has just been baptinged and never leaves those files until the member is transferred due to his business or for porsonal region to another congregation in a different section of Dallas or a different city in the United States. At this time the card is mailed from one congregation to the other and it is never carried on the person of the member. He also stated this card shows the background information regarding a member and his progress in the Jahovah Witnesses congregation.

LCUTORTER further added the only time the name of a Jebovah Vitness would appear on one of their namuals or books would be in a case where the member was acting in the capacity of a lecturer to other members. LCUTORTER stated he is positive that had LEE LANVEY OSTALD or his wife been a member of the Jehovah Uitnesses in the Dallas area he is positive due to his position in the organization he would have had knowledge of the membership. At 10:17 a.m., a telephone call was received from 2 person who identified himself as THORNTON CAINT, a periont at the Veterans Administration Respital, Culiport, Mississippi. He further claimed he heard these two talking together and they sentioned they intended to do bodily harm to the President of the United States. He said he tried to make a collect telephone call to the Prosident in Washington, D. C. to warn him but the White House retused to accept the collect telephone call. He stated this was all the information he had concerning this.

He also stated while at the fair he personally sww RUBY kill a Negro with a knife. This was all the information he had about this.
