INFORMATION CONCERNING JACK LEON RUBY, Also Known As JACK RUBENSTERN

## AT TACOMA, WASHINGTON

On November 24, 1963, Mrs. NATALLE REFYES, 3834 South Favort Avenue, was interviewed by Tacoma Paderal Bureau of Investigation Agents following a tolephonic request to the Seattle Office in which she claimed she might have information concerning JACK RUBY. Mrs. REBYES was immediately contacted by Tacoma Agents and furnished the following information:

In 1946 or 1948 she recalled meeting a man in Los Angeles, California, who identified himself as JOE YCLNG. She recalled meeting JOE YCLNG in a dance hall and described this as a "pickup date". After several meetings with YOUNG he told her his true name mas JACK RUDENSTEIN and also indicated he had been known under the name JACK RUDEN. He further told her that he was employed as a station attendant for a Union Oil Company and at that time he lived on Verdugo Avenue, Clendale, California. During their conversation he also informed her he was an athlest, had never been married and had once traveled in Russia during 1938 and 1939. YOUNG openly Preised both LEMIN and STALIN and after several days requested Mrs. REEVES accompany him to China there he was going to "build bridges".

Mrs. REEVES explained that the recent television photos of JACK LEON RUBY are in some way similar to the person she knew as JOS YOUNG in 1946 and 1948. She coscribed JCS YOUNG as a white male, 51 8" to 5' 10" tall, 170 pounds, with blond way hair and a dimpled chin.

On November 25, 1963, kms. REEVES was re-interviewed at her request and advised that on viewing further photographs of JACK LEON RUBY on the television she did not believe he was identical with the person she knew as JOE YOUNG. She pointed out her reasons for initially reporting this instance ware due to the similarity in names and because of the unusual circumstances surrounding her association with YOUNG.

> ANONYMOUS TELEPHONE CALL NOVEMBER 24, 1963, CONCERNING MORRIS ADELMAN

On November 24, 1963, an anonymous telephone caller contacted the Los Angeles Office and advised SA ROBERT W. HOUSEL, JR. that JACK RUBY, al.a Jacob Rubenstein, "killer of LEE GSWALD," was closely associated with MORRIS ADELMAN, a notorious Communist Party organizer in the Chicago area during World War II. ADELMAN was later in Los Angeles and the Dallas, Fort Worth, and San Antonio, Texas, areas.
