Transmitted herealth are pertinent portions of the case file of Perina Michalcona CUMAD, non PROFAMOVA, the wife of American citizen for Pervey CUMAD. As you will note, the Innigration and Naturalization Service approved for Charles portion for manufact atoms for his wife, but refused to lift the cancilons imposed by Mectica 203(p) of the Innigration and Maticality Act. Therefore, no vice can be issued to Mrs. Cauchd at time office. The Department supported in its ONV-61 to Mascow that Mrs. Ormald apply for her vise in a third country.

For your information, Mr. Omaid in a former W. S. Marine who came to the Soviet Union in 1959 with the intention of settling here. He subsequently experienced a change of heart and is now attempting to return to the United States with the Soviet date and infant doughter (born in February, 1962). The Department has outbrained reneated of Omaid's posperor valid for direct travel, to the United States, and has also authorized a repatriation long for him and he family. A servict foreign passport and exit visa has been received for Nov. Omaid and Omaid himself has appearedly been prediced that he will receive permission to heave the Soviet Union whenever he is ready to travely.

It will be noted from the attached case file that the Department has proviously rendered an advicery spinion that has Saunde's affiliation with the Soviet trule union can be considered involuntary as defined by Scotton 212(a)(25)(1)(1) of the Indigration and Estionality Act. Therefore, there appear to be no nearity grounds for refusing here a visa, provided of course that no further derogatory information comes to light during the formel visa interview.

Perions the most questionable aspect of Hrs. Goueld's application is the weak evidence which has been presented to overcors the public charge provision of the Act. The Embrary has conducted considerable correspondence with Hr. Gounds concerning this point. It appears that he can find no one in the United States who is able and willing to execute an affident of support for his wife. Furthernore, Gould has been
