Transmitted herowith are copies of correspondence received from Mr. Osmald since the Debassy's communication under reference as well as a copy of the Nebassy's letter to Mr. Oswald dated January 15, 1962.

It will be noted from Mr. Oswald's letter of January 5, 1962, that he has been issued a now Soriet readinces document which is valid until July 5, 1962. In his letter, Mr. Oswald also informs the Debesey that he has received assurance from the Soriet authorities that he may recoive cut documentation upon request valid for 15 days. The Erbassy has already been formally notified by the Hinistry of Foreign Affairs of the issues to these, Oswald of a foreign passport containing an exit view valid until December 1, 1962.

Moreover, Mr. Osmald's letter of January 5 states that he wishes to delay his departure from the UER until his wife's immigrant wise documentation is complete in order that they say depart together. Mr. Oswald also indicates that his wife is expecting a child in March.

Finally, Mr. Osvald's latent letter raises the matter of a loan to defray part of the cost of air travel to the U. S. for himself and Mrs. Osvald.

Action Requested: The Department is requested to advise the Dabnesy as soon as possible whether we are sutherized to make a loss for air travel to the Cowalds under the sutherity contained in 2 FM k22 without further reference with the Department. If not, the Department is requested to sutherite such a loss on a contingency basis.
